INTRODUCTION

The Peacekeeper Ethics Committee (PEC), located in the Mohawk Territory of Kahnawá:ke, established by the Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke pursuant to the *Kahnawá:ke Peacekeepers Law (Amended by MCR # 8/2005-2006 on 17 Kenténha/October, 2005)*. The Peacekeeper Ethics Committee (PEC) was instituted (*by MCED # 56/2006-2007 on November 13, 2006*) to consider complaints made by any person against one or more members of the Kahnawá:ke Peacekeepers and to make recommendations to the Peacekeeper Services Board (PSB) for the modification of administrative or operational practices that, in the opinion of the Peacekeeper Ethics Committee (PEC), will enable the Kahnawá:ke Peacekeepers to fulfill their mandate more efficiently, effectively and in accordance with the needs and expectations of the Mohawk People of Kahnawá:ke. The Peacekeeper Ethics Committee (PEC) is ultimately accountable to the Mohawks of Kahnawá:ke for all of its actions. The Peacekeeper Ethics Committee (PEC) is accountable to the Peacekeeper Services Board (PSB) and the Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke. This is done on an annual basis through presentation of an annual report at a regular meeting of the Peacekeeper Services Board (PSB) and of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke.
